Description of the organisation

Ufficio Scolastico Regionale of Tuscany Region is a joint regional body within the Ministry of Education, University and Research. It mainly works as link between the Ministry and the autonomous schools (more than 600 schools subdivided into preschool, primary and secondary schools). Ufficio Scolastico Regionale controls and monitors the achievement of educational objectives promoted by the Ministry of Education, University and Research. Ufficio Scolastico Regionale promotes and disseminates regional educational policies addressed to students.

Experience of the organization in previous European projects

Ufficio Scolastico Regionale already participated in the project "Digital Natives 4 democracy" funded by the Comenius Regio Programme. The project aimed at increasing formal and informal educational settings education for active citizenship. The overall goal was to develop and implement methodologies to systematically support educational institutions in the realization of educational and educational courses related to themes like democracy, participation and sustainability. Within this project, Ufficio Scolastico Regionale promoted educational innovation through the use of new technologies.

Ufficio Scolastico Regionale is currently participating in the project "Robotics Opportunities (to foster) STEM Education ROSE"(Erasmus+, Key Action 2) to be completed in August 2017. The project has the general objective to enhance the use of robotics in kindergarten education and to encourage the dissemination of STEM.

A second KA2 project in which Ufficio Scolastico Regionale is partner (2015/2018) is the T.E.S.T. Project, in cooperation with University of Pisa. The project aims at supporting scientific and technological disciplines, enhancing a "learning by doing" approach.

Ufficio Scolastico Regionale is also coordinating two KA1 Staff project, the first called "Party-cipate" (2015/2017), aiming at promoting kindergarten teachers' training by the certification of their skills, the second called "Days" (2016/2018), to implement digital trainers preparation.

Experience and Expertise of the organization in the project's subject area

Ufficio Scolastico Regionale has previously collaborated with secondary education institutions and with University in various projects concerning inclusion, tolerance and understanding within school communities.

Contributions that can be provided to the project

The role of the Ufficio Scolastico Regionale staff in the project will be enhanced by the possibility of using the channels it developed in his careers, in order to involve teachers and to disseminate information about the current project and in order to involve also Policy makers to participate at Italian focus group.

In addition, the Ufficio Scolastico Regionale staff will involve five pre-elementary schools.

Each school will identify some teachers and they will work in cooperation with the project partners for researching on the cultural and historical background of traditional tales and for collecting them. After that they will use the repository with their pupils.
