

Practical Activity 5: Different socks – Game meant for the stimulation of diversity

Description of the Practical Activity: Kids are asked to come to kindergarten wearing different socks. A dialogue starts regarding the differences that make us unique. The main message is that people, like socks, are different, but equal. Each kid is asked to compliment the classmate on his/her right for his/her choice "I like that you chose the blue colour", etc.
