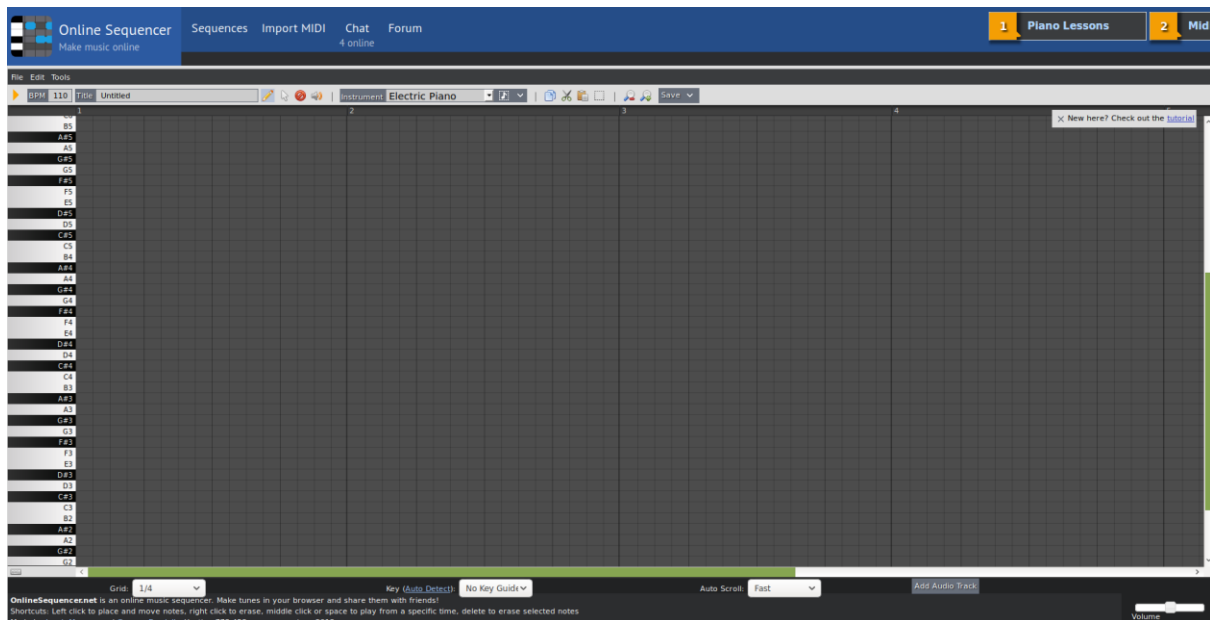


Practical Activity 1: Composing songs with online sequencer

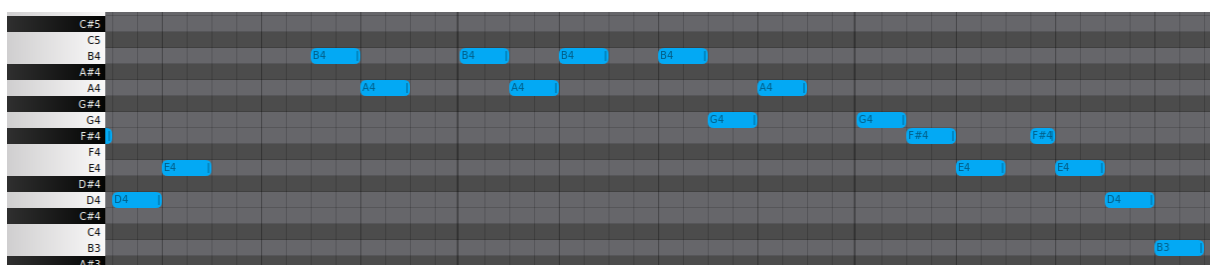
Description of the practical activity: in this practical activity we are going to compose a simple song with Online sequencer, (<https://onlinesequencer.net/>) an online tool to working with MIDI and, then, we are going to save it in mp3.

When we enter in the web, we can see this blank MIDI sequencer. At left we can see the pitch, at top we can select some details, for example, the instrument and the speed.



We can draw with the mouse the notes:

- One click to one single note.
- Right click to erase the note.
- Click and drag to expand the note duration.
- Click and drag to move the note in time or pitch.



You can create and edit the notes you want or see others compositions made by other users. At left top you can see a Play symbol and you can listen your creation.

When you are satisfied with the result, you can download the MIDI and convert with Hamienet (<http://www.hamienet.com/midi2mp3>) or an specific software like Muse Score (<https://musescore.org/es>).
